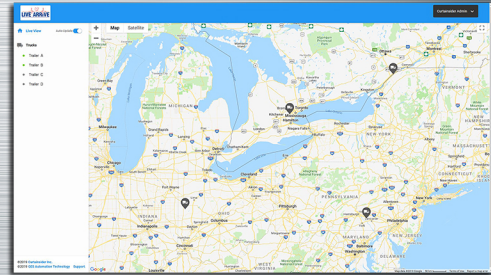
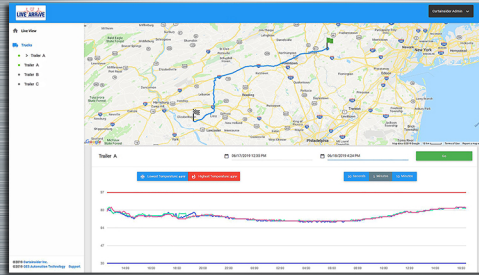
Poultry Liftroof for Auto Unload Systems

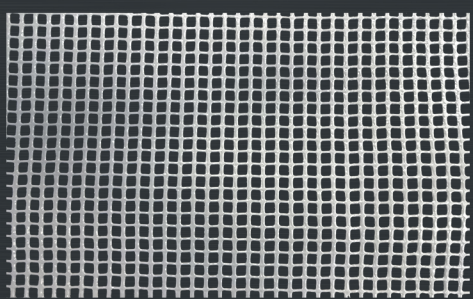
